Dog Control

The Village Board has contracted with Greg Starley to serve as the Dog Control Officer. He may be reached by calling 648-4801 Ext. 8 you will reach the Town of Fenton answering system where you can leave a message or receive further information in case of an emergency. You may also contact the Village of Whitney Point at 692-4907 during regular business hours. The Dog Control local law is available for review on the village website and also at the Village Clerk's office.

*****A Note to Landlords:** It is your responsibility to notify your tenants of the Dog Control law. Dogs must be leashed and not allowed to run at large within the village.

REMINDERS:

Hydrant Flushing: Public Works will be flushing out water hydrants in Whitney Point and Lisle starting the week of August 5th through the 16th. If water is discolored homeowners should run the tap until it is clear.

Lawns: Lawns must be maintained, by the trimming of weeds and the mowing of grass. This promotes the integrity of a neighborhood and prevents health and safety hazards.
