Items to be collected are: Computers, monitors, printers, TV's, VCR's, modems, stereos, laptops, keyboards, radios, fax machines, cell phones.

These items should be placed at the curb, <u>separate</u> from your bulk refuse and trash.

## Sewer Rate Increase

On April 30, 2020 the Village Board voted to increase the sewer rate from \$45.00 to \$55.00 for the first 1000 cubic feet; and from \$3.50 to \$4.50 for each 100 cubic feet thereafter. You will notice the increase in this current billing period.
